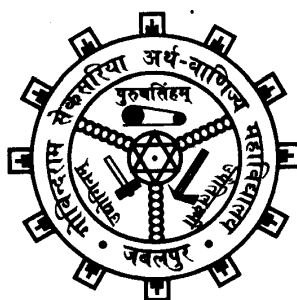

The abstract should include the need for research, objectives, hypothesis, methodology, data analysis, findings and keywords. They should adhere to the following -

FULL PAPER SUBMISSION :

The full paper must include a clear indication of the research methodology adopted, major findings, results, implications and key references. Authors should adhere to the following -
